With a confirmed case in Wichita County, The City of Electra continues taking steps to help prevent the spread of Covid19. This is a very fluid action plan and may change.

Currently the lobby of City Hall is closed to the public. We ask that if you come to city hall to make a payment, to please use the night deposit located on the south side of the building. We will mail you your receipt. We are still inside working and are able to take payments with credit or debit cards over the phone, and to take your calls concerning any matter.

The Senior Center will continue to provide meals on wheel lunches. If you come to the center to eat, you will be provided a take-out meal. We are not allowing in center dining at this time.

The Library will continue to allow you to return and check out books. We are discontinuing the use of the public computers at this time.

Municipal Court is available by phone only. You may make payments online or in City Halls night deposit.

All other departments are in normal operation.
